HOUSTON, TEXAS

Region 10: Great Gulf Coast

Region 10 is home of The Ladies, who won the Novice Award at the 2018 International Quartet Competition. The Great Gulf Coast Region includes portions of Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi and Alabama in the United States.

March 26-28, 2020

BAKERSFIELD, CALIFORNIA

Region 11: Sequoia Pacifica

Region 11 covers the United States' central and southern California and Las Vegas, Nevada. The Sequoia Pacifica Region is home to seven International Champion Quartets and an International Champion Chorus (San Diego, 1975).

CONCORD, NORTH CAROLINA

Region 14: Heart of the Blue Ridge

Region 14 Heart of the Blue Ridge is home to International Champion Quartet Speed of Sound (2016) as well as three members of the Rising Star Champion Quartet, Hot Pursuit. The region is home to 20 choruses and numerous quartets. It encompasses parts of Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia.

WICHITA, KANSAS

Region 25: Heart of America

Region 25 Heart of America is comprised of choruses and quartets from seven states, stretching from northwest Texas to Tennessee in the United States. It includes Oklahoma, where Sweet Adelines International was founded and is home to several Internationally-recognized choruses and quartets, including Rich-Tone Chorus (five-time International Champions) and 2019 Most Entertaining Quartet, Titanium.

COVINGTON, KENTUCKY

Region 4: Harmony Heartland

Region 4 Harmony Heartland includes sections of Alabama, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio, Tennessee and West Virginia in the United States. The region is home to 20 choruses and 50 quartets. Region 4 boasts two International Chorus Champions (including five-time winners Gem City Chorus), five International Quartet Champions and four Harmony Classic Champions.

ST. CATHARINES, ONTARIO, CANADA

Region 16: Lake Ontario

Region 16 encompasses Canadian and United States regions around Lake Ontario, for which they are named. This region is home to 22 choruses, including five-time International Champion Chorus, North Metro Chorus.

RAPID CITY, SOUTH DAKOTA

Region 8: Rocky Mountain

Region 8 Rocky Mountain includes Colorado, Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas, Utah and Wyoming in the United States. The region is home to 16 choruses and 25 quartets, including Skyline Chorus, which placed in the top 5 in the 2018 Sweet Adelines International Chorus Competition.

PHOENIX, ARIZONA

Region 21: Golden West

Region 21 Golden West encompasses southern California, Arizona, New Mexico, West Texas and Hawaii in the United States. The region is home to several multi-year Sweet Adelines International Champion choruses, including most recently Scottsdale Chorus (2019, for its 6th time) and 2015 Rising Star Quartet Champions C'est La Vie.

APPLETON, WISCONSIN

Region 3: Midwest Harmony

Region 3 is home to the winners of the most international gold medals in Sweet Adelines history, the Melodeers Chorus. The chorus has brought home seven international gold medals, most recently in 2015. The Midwest Harmony Region spans an area of the United States from South Bend, Indiana in the east to Madison, Wisconsin in the west and down to Peoria, Illinois.

CEDAR RAPIDS, IOWA

Region 5: Spirit of the Midwest

Region 5 Spirit of the Midwest is the home of eleven International Champion Quartets, including the 2019 Queens of Harmony, ClassRing, the first Sweet Adelines International Champion Quartet, the Decaturettes (1947) and the longest-running Sweet Adelines chapter, Kansas City Chorus. Spirit of the Midwest is made up of parts of Kansas, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri and Nebraska in the United States.

SPRINGFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS

Region 1: North Atlantic

Region 1 North Atlantic covers New England and Northern New York, USA, as well as Quebec, Canada.

Region 1 currently has 22 chartered choruses and more than 30 quartets.

SPOKANE, WASHINGTON

Region 13: North by Northwest

Region 13 North by Northwest encompasses Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Oregon and Washington in the United States. The region is home to four International Quartet Champions, most recently Frenzy! (2017) and several quartets and choruses who placed in the Top 10 at International Competition.

CALGARY, ALBERTA, CANADA

Region 26: Canadian Maple Leaf

The only all-Canadian region, Region 26 Canadian Maple Leaf, includes Yukon Territory, Northwest Territories and the provinces of British Columbia, Alberta, and Saskatchewan. It is home to several Internationally-competing choruses and quartets, including Vocal Motion! Chorus, which placed in the top 5 Harmony Classic Division A Chorus Competition in 2018.

SPARKS, NEVADA

Region 12: Pacific Shores

The Pacific Shores Region encompasses northern California, northern Nevada, southern Oregon and Hawaii in the United States. Region 12 is home to 2014 International Quartet Champions, LoveNotes.

LANCASTER, PENNSYLVANIA

Region 19: Atlantic Bay-Mountain

Region 19 Atlantic Bay-Mountain includes parts of Delaware, Maryland, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Virginia in the United States. The region is home to 1983 Sweet Adelines International Chorus Champions Valley Forge and nine International Champion Quartets, including most recently, Lustre (2018).

DEARBORN, MICHIGAN

Region 2: Border Lakes

Region 2 Border Lakes is comprised of Michigan in the United States and Ontario in Canada. The region is home to several Division A and AA choruses that have placed in the top 5 at international competition over the years.

DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA

Region 9: Coastal Harmony

Region 9 Coastal Harmony encompasses Florida, southern Georgia and the southernmost tip of South Carolina in the United States. The Coastal Harmony Region is home to the lead of 2005 International Champion Quartet, "the BUZZ", who also sang with the region's 1994 International Champion Quartet, Showtime and to the tenor of 2013 International Quartet Champions Touché (who is also the current president of Sweet Adelines International).

CLEVELAND, OHIO

Region 17: Great Lakes Harmony

Region 17 Great Lakes Harmony contains parts of Indiana, Michigan, New York, Ohio and Pennsylvania in the United States. The region is home to several choruses and quartets that compete internationally, including Greater Harmony, which competed on the international stage in 2018.

ROCHESTER, MINNESOTA

Region 6: Northern Lights

Region 6 Northern Lights covers the lower parts of Manitoba and Ontario in Canada as well as North Dakota, South Dakota, Minnesota, part of Wisconsin and northern Iowa in the United States. The Northern Lights Region is home to home to 19 choruses and many quartets, including three International Champion Quartets: 4-Star Collection (1997), The Music Gallery (1982), and Note Cracker Sweets (1964).

HELSINGBORG, SWEDEN

Region 32: Nordic Light

Region 32 Nordic Light includes Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden. It includes several internationally-recognized choruses and quartets, including Malmö Limelight Chorus (Harmony Classic Division A, 2018), Rönninge Show Chorus (International Chorus, 2017, 2016 and 2013) and Growing Girls (Quartet, 1989).

WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND

Region 35: New Zealand

As its name suggests, Region 35 covers New Zealand. It is the home of several internationally-recognized choruses and quartets, mostly recently 2018 Harmony Classic Division AA Champions, Wellington City Chorus, and Bella A Cappella Chorus, which placed in the top 5 in 2018 Harmony Classic Division A.

ALBANY, NEW YORK

Region 15: Greater NY/NJ

Region 15 stretches from northern New Jersey across Long Island, NY, north of Albany, NY and west toward Rochester, NY. The Greater NY/NJ Region is home to Sirens of Gotham, 2018 Harmony Classic Division A Champions.

CARDIFF, WALES, UNITED KINGDOM

Region 31: Quartet of Nations

Established in 1999, Region 31 Quartet of Nations includes England, Scotland, Wales and the Netherlands. The region is home to several Internationally-recognized choruses and quartets, including most recently No Borders Show Chorus, which was selected as Most Entertaining Chorus in the 2018 Harmony Classic competition.

SANDY BAY, TASMANIA, AUSTRALIA

Region 34: Southern Cross

Region 34 Southern Cross covers all of Australia and boasts 32 choruses and 47 quartets. It is home to several internationally-recognized choruses and quartets, most recently Circular Keys Chorus, which placed in the top 5 at the 2018 Harmony Classic Division A competition.
