SWEET ADELINES INTERNATIONAL PERMISSION TO ARRANGE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Arranger initiates the process by completing *Request for Permission to Arrange* form and submitting it along with appropriate handling fees to international headquarters. Handling fees are as follows:

Members of International Music Arrangers Program (IMAP)	\$15 PER SONG
Non-IMAP members of Sweet Adelines International	\$20 PER SONG
Non-members	\$25 PER SONG

Because there is often more than one song of the same title, please include as much information as possible on your request form (e.g. composer name, publisher name and address, copyright date, etc.).

If you are asking for a medley or parody, specify this and include other titles and all lyric changes.

2. Staff contacts publisher(s) requesting permission to arrange.
3. As soon as a response is received from publisher(s), the required fee is paid to them. The arranger receives notification from staff in the form of a *Permission to Arrange Invoice* for the publisher's fees and gives details of publisher requirements, including the copyright notice.

In the event the permission fee charged by the song owner is in excess of \$100, the arranger is contacted by staff to confirm continued interest.

4. Upon receipt of notification of clearance, arranger returns a completed copy of the invoice indicating distribution preference, a copy of the arrangement in required format and payment to international headquarters. It is recommended that the arranger retain a copy of the response form for her files.
5. The arranger sends us a neat legible letter-size copy free of personal notations (preferably in electronic format) with required copyright notice affixed on the bottom of the first page of the arrangement. **The arrangement will not be added to the inventory without sheet music.** Contracts with the publisher(s) provide that we send them a copy of the completed arrangement.
6. Preview copies of arrangements are available through International Sales. Payment to Sweet Adelines International for the fees of copies of any arrangement can be made over the phone or through our website.
