- An official transcript from your current university; email or online versions are not acceptable
- Completed application form
- List of musical activities
- List of extracurricular and civic activities
- Three letters of recommendation, written on letterhead, signed, and dated, which specifically address student's overall strengths and weaknesses and reference her Sweet Adelines experience, if known.
- Four completed essay questions
 - Answer all essay questions on separate sheets of paper, typed, including your name and contact information
 - List all schools attended since high school with formal address and field of study.
 - What are your aspirations and goals for your musical future?
 - What steps have you taken to reach the musical future you envision?
 - What will you be doing in ten years?

ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS
