

Health & Safety FAQ for 2022 International Convention and Competition

1. Is being vaccinated against COVID-19 required to register for 2022 International Convention and Competition?

With the safety and well-being of SA members and attendees held in the highest regard, the International Board of Directors made the decision to require that all on-site attendees, faculty, exhibitors, staff and competitors be either fully vaccinated OR test negative for COVID-19 within 72 hours of Sunday, September 11, 2022.

2. What about competitors?

Competitors will be required to adhere to the same health and safety protocols as all attendees in order to attend International Convention and Competition in Phoenix, Ariz. (USA).

3. What does it mean to be “fully vaccinated”?

A person is considered fully vaccinated:

- *Two weeks after their second dose in a two-dose vaccine series*, such as Pfizer and Moderna.*
- *Two weeks after a single-dose vaccine*, such as Johnson & Johnson.*

This applies to all COVID-19 vaccines authorized for use and emergency use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, and COVID-19 vaccines authorized for emergency use by the World Health Organization, as well as vaccines authorized or approved by the national health authority of the country where it was administered on or before **August 22, 2022.*

4. What vaccines are accepted?

*SA will accept all COVID-19 vaccines authorized for use and emergency use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, and COVID-19 vaccines authorized for emergency use by the World Health Organization, as well as vaccines authorized or approved by the national health authority of the country where it was administered on or before **August 22, 2022**.*

5. What if I am not vaccinated and wish to submit proof of a negative COVID-19 test?

- *Attendees will be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 (Rapid, Molecular, PCR, or Antigen) test within 72 hours prior to Sunday, September 11, 2022. Antigen home testing kits with compatible app for results will be accepted, which includes [On/Go](#), [BinaxNOW with Navica App](#), and [Ellume](#). At home tests not using an app to collect result will not be accepted.*
- *On-site testing will be available.*

6. When will I be required to present proof of vaccine or my negative test result?

Attendees will be required to upload a proof of vaccine or negative test result to ShareMy.Health prior to entering the Competition Area. Registered attendees with email addresses in our database will be able to login to www.sharemy.health with the email used to login to the Sweet Adelines International database. For those gaining clearance via negative test, the option to upload negative test will not be available until Friday, September 9th. Attendees that were able to upload documents prior to arrival will be emailed a cleared health passport to show on-site for health clearance. Those who were not able to upload their information will be able to visit the Health and Safety Desk in Hall B (See [Phoenix Schedule](#) for hours) to create a login and receive clearance.

7. Are minors required to uphold the same health and safety requirements?

Yes, all attendees are required to either be vaccinated or test negative for COVID-19 if they are 6 months or older.

8. What happens if I register, but then feel unsafe attending closer to the event date?

We understand that the last few years have given everyone their fair share of unknowns and concerns. Due to the unpredictable nature of COVID-19, for this year's event, all registrations will be fully refundable up until the event date. 9. Will there be a mask requirement for events?

The city of Phoenix has lifted its indoor mask mandate and the CDC launched new guidance regarding COVID-19 Community Levels. As a result, masks are not mandated in indoor settings, including the Phoenix Convention Center and the Hotels. Wearing a mask at the convention & competition is a personal choice and we ask that everyone makes their choice responsibly. Given the numbers of individuals and competitors coming from around the world, we strongly encourage participants to wear masks (KN95, N95, or surgical masks) throughout the event. All attendees should be mindful and respectful of other attendees' health choices. We ask that participants honor the requests of others to mask up and/or maintain physical distancing.

10. Will there be a virtual option for those that are unable to attend in person?
