Single Slide \$115 ea

Deadlines and Submission Information:

July 31: Closing date for advertising reservations

August 9: Closing date for all artwork file submissions. No refunds will be made after artwork submission deadline.

Mechanical Requirements:

- Slides should be designed in Microsoft PowerPoint and set to wide-screen (16:9)
- Format (1280 x 720 pixels)
- Photos used in slides should be high resolution (300 dpi)
- Files should be saved as a .pptx
- Audio is not permitted
- Slide animations and transitions must auto play within a 12-second timeframe

Things to Remember:

- A confirmation email will be sent after on-line purchase through the SA store.
- Payment must be received via credit card in full before being processed.

Important Reminders!

If your jumbotron submission has multiple frames that transition, it must be created as a <u>single slide with transitions</u>, <u>not separate slides</u>. Do not submit files with separate slides/frames or you will be <u>charged per slide</u>.

If your slide submission contains transitions, please ensure that it is set to <u>transition</u> <u>automatically</u> and not by a mouse click. Entire slide transitions should not exceed 12 seconds. Both of these features can be set and tested within the PowerPoint file before your slide is submitted.
