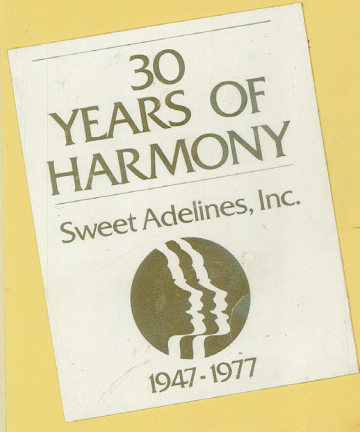

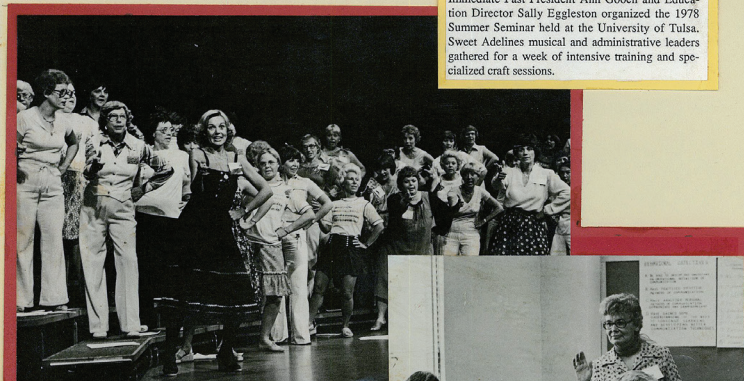
"30 YEARS OF HARMONY" RELEASED



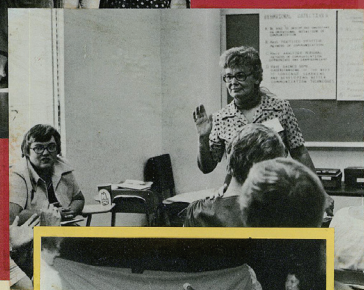
