278TH (SUMMER) MEETING
INTERNATIONAL UPDATE

The International Board of Directors met on June 9-10, 2017, in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Following is a summary of actions taken.

The Board participated in a daylong Strategic Planning session.

The charter and chapter membership for the following chapters were authorized:

- Acappella Sound Chapter, Region 31, Roche, Cornwall, England, UK
- Basically Treble Chapter, Region 25, The Colony, Texas, USA

In addition to inviting members to perform with the Family Chorus and World Harmony Chorus (every other year) at International Convention, the Board approved the addition of a Mixed Family Chorus performance to be offered every third year at International Convention.

International President Paula Davis announced that she had selected Nancy Field as the recipient of the 2017 President's Lifetime Achievement Award.

Jenny Lawson of Surrey Harmony Chorus, Region 31 was selected as the recipient of the 2017 Ann Gooch Award.

Annette Lambrecht of Windsong Chorus, Region 8 was selected as the recipient of the 2017 National Association for Music Education (NAfME) Award.

The Board was pleased to learn that one \$5,000 Bev Sellers Memorial Scholarship had been awarded by the Young Singers Foundation Advancement Committee.
