



Regional Rehearsal Liaison

As many choruses navigate the possibility of returning to in-person rehearsal, it is important that the International Headquarters and regions maintain a partnership to provide the best possible support and resources. The Regional Rehearsal Liaison is an appointed position for a period of one year with the potential another term if needed.

The Regional Rehearsal Liaison does NOT have to be a member of the RMT and may consist of multiple individuals or a team. Below are the responsibilities of the position:

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Must familiarize themselves with resources provided by HQ
- Work with choruses and quartets to create a comprehensive back to rehearsal plan/guide
- Assist choruses in understanding their local government COVID guidance as well as their government's medical privacy laws
- May facilitate Zoom meetings with chorus contacts to share ideas and progress
- Work with choruses to resolve conflict specific to in-person rehearsal
- Maintain contact with the Director of Membership at HQ and provide feedback to HQ
- Identify and share information on gaps in resources with HQ
- Communicate with Regional Rehearsal Liaisons from other regions
- When necessary, escalate issues to HQ
- Maintain records of chorus/quartet rehearsal plans
- Train successor
